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Section 1. <u>Initiatives for efficiency in state</u> government; span of control and layers of management; job

classification system and total quality management .-- It is the

18 intent of the Legislature to restore the confidence of

their work. The Legislature supports the concept of total quality management achieved through an incremental long-ter

the citizens of Florida. In order to accomplish these goals, the following initiatives shall be performed:

(1) SPAN OF CONTROL AND LAYERS OF MANAGEMENT.--

(a) The Department of Management Services shall work with the executive agencies to reduce the layers of management

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in such agencies by a goal of 50 percent and increase agency-wide employee-to-supervisor ratios by up to 50 percent by July 1, 1999. The department shall present an interim report to the Legislature by October 15, 1998, and a final report by October 15, 1999, including past efficiency methods undertaken by an agency to accomplish the intent of this legislation and the progress of the department in completing this task and its outcome.

- (b) Prior to implementing any reduction in the layers of management, the Department of Management Services shall notify the legislative fiscal committee in each house of the Legislature regarding the proposed reduction. The notification shall include:
  - 1. A description of the proposed reduction.
- 2. A list of the positions and employment responsibilities to be eliminated or reduced.
  - 3. A list of activities to be eliminated or reduced.
- 4. An estimate of savings expected to result from the reduction of layers of management.
- 5. Another appropriate percentage should 50 percent be detrimental to the improvement of services to the citizens of Florida.
- Management Services shall simplify the state's system of job classification for state employees by reducing the number of job classifications, providing for a technical skill-based career path in state employment which does not depend on the employee's gaining supervisory responsibility to gain advancement, and providing incentives for state employees to broaden their knowledge and skill base. The department shall present an interim report to the Legislature by October 15,

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1998, and a final report by October 15, 1999, regarding the
    progress of the department in completing this task and its
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    outcome.
