**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 2, lines 6-15, delete those lines

and insert: ticket purchaser. Sales from a vending ~~To be~~  
~~authorized~~ a machine must: be under the supervision and within  
the direct line of sight of the lottery retailer to ensure  
that the machine is monitored and only operated by persons at  
least 18 years of age, and the machine must be equipped with  
an operational lockout device that is under the control of the  
dealer or the dealer's agent or employee who directly  
regulates the sale of items through the machine by triggering  
the lockout device to allow the dispensing of instant lottery  
tickets. The lockout device must include a mechanism to  
prevent the machine from functioning if the power source for  
the lockout device fails or if the lockout device is disabled  
~~capable of being electronically deactivated by the retailer to~~  
~~prohibit use by persons less than 18 years of age through the~~  
~~use of a lockout device that maintains the machine's~~  
~~deactivation for a period of no less than 5 minutes; and be~~
