Section 1. (1) Each school district shall establish and publish policies requiring the content and regular issuance of student report cards for all elementary school, middle school, and high school students. These report cards must clearly depict and grade both:

(a) The student's academic performance in each class or course, which must be based upon examinations as well as written papers, class participation, and other academic performance criteria.

25 26 (b) The student's conduct. The conduct grade must consist of both the student's attendance, including absences and tardiness, and the student's behavior, including manners, deportment, and attire.

(2) School districts shall not allow schools to exempt students from academic performance requirements based on practices or policies designed to encourage student attendance.
