Senator Geller moved the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 24, line 21, after the period

insert: In consideration for the limitation on liability with respect to injuries caused by the operation of rental vehicles which liability is granted by this subsection to companies that engage in the business of renting motor vehicles in this state and for the resulting increase in the uncompensated health care burden that will be borne by Florida health care providers, each rental company that rents or leases vehicles for a term of less than 1 year shall be assessed the amount of \$2 per rental vehicle per rental day, which shall be paid into the Public Medical Assistance Trust Fund. The foregoing assessment for uncompensated health care shall be indexed on July 1 of each year in accordance with the medical care component of the consumer price index.
