(2) A nonresident is subject to the same laws and 29 30 restrictions with respect to carrying a concealed weapon or

concealed firearm as a resident who is so licensed.

(3) If the resident of another state who is the holder of a valid license to carry a concealed weapon or concealed firearm issued in another state establishes legal residence in this state has registered to vote, has made a statement of domicile pursuant to s. 222.17, Florida Statutes, or has filed for homestead tax exemption on property in this state, the license shall remain in effect for 90 days following the date on which the holder of the license establishes legal state residence. The provisions of this section apply only to states which have reciprocity with Florida with respect to the issuance of a concealed weapon or concealed firearm permit. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1997.
