House Resolution

A resolution honoring Dr. Benjamin L. Perry.

WHEREAS, Dr. Benjamin L. Perry was born February 27, 1918, in Eatonville, Florida, and moved to Tallahassee when his father accepted a faculty position at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, FAMU, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perry received a Bachelor of Science degree in agricultural education from FAMU in 1940, received a Master of Science degree in agricultural economics from Iowa State University in 1942 and returned to FAMU to become an instructor in economics, and received a Ph.D. from Cornell University in land economics in 1954, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perry returned to FAMU to begin a distinguished career as a professor of economics and a university administrator, was Dean of Students for 8 years, became a member of the Michigan State University Advisory Team for the United States Agency for International Development and was Dean of Student Affairs at the University of Nigeria, was FAMU's first Director of Research and Grants, became the Dean of Administration, and later became the sixth President of FAMU, serving in that capacity from 1968 to 1977, and

WHEREAS, as President of FAMU, Dr. Perry thoroughly reorganized that institution, being responsible for establishment of the FAMU Foundation, the Basic Studies and Thirteen College Curriculum Programs, the School of Business and Industry, the School of Architecture, the Black Archives, Research Center and Museum, and the Cluster program, and

WHEREAS, Dr. Perry, despite numerous strong and persistent forces supporting the merger or abolition of FAMU,

was successful in fighting to save FAMU as an autonomous and $\,$ independent institution, NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida: That the House of Representatives hereby recognizes the achievements, contributions, and service of Dr. Benjamin L. Perry to Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University, especially his efforts to preserve FAMU as an independent and accredited institution of higher learning.
