House Resolution

A resolution commending the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team for its services to the citizens of Central Florida.

WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team began emergency helicopter services on October 13, 1984, and

WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team was the first air ambulance program in Florida accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Air Medical Services, and

WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team regularly serves a fifteen-county area including Orange, Osceola, Seminole, Brevard, Lake, Polk, Sumter, Marion, Citrus, Volusia, Putnam, Indian River, Okeechobee, Hardee, and Desoto Counties, and

WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team transports approximately 850 trauma, critical-care pediatric, high-risk obstetrical, cardiac, and neurosurgical patients annually, and

WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team has transported nearly 8,800 patients since beginning services to Central Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida:

That the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care Team is hereby recognized and commended for its services to the citizens of Central Florida.
