L8	WHEREAS, the Orlando Regional Medical Center Air Care
L9	Team transports approximately 850 trauma, critical-care
20	pediatric, high-risk obstetrical, cardiac, and neurosurgical

23	Team has transported nearly 8,800 patients since beginning
