 WHEREAS, since its beginning in 1945 when the home provided care for just 23 elderly Jewish widows and widowers in a one-story house, the Miami Jewish Home has grown into the largest nonprofit provider of comprehensive and humanistic geriatric care, services, and programs in the Southeastern United States, and

 WHEREAS, the Miami Jewish Home has preserved its guiding philosophy of fostering independent living for the elderly with dignity and has continually expanded its dynamic programs and services to meet the diverse needs of Florida's rapidly growing elderly population, and

WHEREAS, when describing the Miami Jewish Home, Judge Irving Cypen who has served as Chairman of the Board and Honorary President for more than 40 years says, "This is not where you come to idle away your twilight years, it is where you come to have a second chance at life," and

WHEREAS, the Miami Jewish Home today provides a second chance at life for more than 600 residents and an estimated 8,000 others through outreach centers and programs throughout the state, and
