The attestation shall be made annually in 12 a form and format determined by the department. 13 14 (d) Any voluntary contributions authorized by law shall be distributed only to an organization under an 15 appropriation by the Legislature. 16 (6) By February 1 each year, the department shall 17 determine which recipients have not complied with subsection 18 19 (5). If the department determines that an organization has not complied or has failed to use the revenues in accordance with 20 law, the department must discontinue the distribution of the 21 revenues to the organization until the department determines 22 that the organization has complied. If an organization fails 23 24 to comply within 12 months after the voluntary contributions 25 are withheld by the department, the proceeds shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund to 26 27 offset department costs.
