1 House Resolution 2 A resolution recognizing the 50th anniversary 3 of Pensacola Junior College. 4 5 WHEREAS, Pensacola Junior College was the first public 6 community college established under an act of the 1947 Florida 7 Legislature and signed into law by Governor LeRoy Collins, and 8 WHEREAS, Pensacola Junior College established its 9 operations on the corner of Cervantes and Palafox Streets on September 8, 1948, in the City of Pensacola, and admitted its 10 11 first students on September 13, 1948, and WHEREAS, Pensacola Junior College has served all 12 13 citizens of Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties since that time, 14 with current facilities in Pensacola, Warrington, Milton, NAS/Pensacola, and Downtown Pensacola, and 15 16 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Presidents Henry L. Ashmore, T. Felton Harrison, Horace E. Hartsell, and 17 President-elect Charles A. Atwell, along with members of the 18 Board of Trustees, Pensacola Junior College has served the 19 20 community with ever-expanding higher education opportunities, 21 and 22 WHEREAS, Pensacola Junior College has provided higher education opportunities to thousands of students since 1948 23 24 and cultural, athletic, and social opportunities to many 25 thousands more during the same period, and 26 WHEREAS, Pensacola Junior College has provided 27 associate in arts degree transfer opportunities, associate in 28 science degree career opportunities, and invaluable assistance 29 to business, industry, and government for fifty years, and WHEREAS, on September 13, 1998, Pensacola Junior 30 College will celebrate its first half-century of service to 31 1
