Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 320.08053, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

320.08053 Requirements for requests to establish specialty license plates .--

- (1) An organization that is not already authorized under s. 320.08058(3) and that seeks the establishment of a new specialty license plate for which an annual use fee is to be charged must submit to the department:
- (a) A request for the particular specialty license plate sought, describing the proposed specialty license plate in general terms.
- (b) A petition, on a form approved by the department, signed by 10,000 or more residents who state their intent to purchase the requested specialty license plate.
- (c) An application fee, not to exceed \$30,000, to defray the department's cost for reviewing the application and developing the specialty license plate.
- (d) A marketing strategy outlining short-term and long-term marketing plans for the requested specialty license plate and a financial analysis outlining the anticipated revenues and the planned expenditures of the revenues to be

30 31 derived from the sale of the requested specialty license plates.

The information required under this subsection must be submitted at least 90 days before the convening of the next regular session of the Legislature.

Section 2. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, 1996 Supplement, is amended to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.--

- (3) COLLEGIATE LICENSE PLATES. --
- (a) The department shall develop a collegiate license plate as provided in this section for <u>all of the 10</u> state <u>universities</u> and <u>the</u> independent universities domiciled in this state. Collegiate license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department as appropriate for each state and independent university. The word "Florida" must be stamped across the bottom of the plate in small letters.
- (b) A collegiate plate annual use fee is to be distributed to the state or independent university foundation designated by the purchaser for deposit in an unrestricted account. The Board of Regents shall require each state university to submit a plan for approval of the expenditure of all funds so designated. These funds may be used only for academic enhancement, including scholarships and private fundraising activities.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* HOUSE SUMMARY Directs the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop a collegiate license plate for all of the 10 state universities and the independent universities domiciled in this state.
