22	<u>Lake Apopka, the St. John's River Water Management District is</u>		
23	<u>directed to pursue the immediate acquisition of all remaining</u>		
24	<u>privately owned lands as identified under s. 373.461, Florida</u>		
25	<u>Statutes. The St. John's River Water Management District is</u>		
26	<u>authorized to purchase such properties pursuant to the</u>
