Section 287.0015, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 26 27 287.0015 Legislative procurement of commodities and 28 services; competitive bid requirements -- The Legislature, when 29 procuring commodities and services, shall follow the 30 requirements with respect to use of competitive bidding which 31

are applicable to agencies of the executive branch under this chapter. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998. SENATE SUMMARY Prohibits persons convicted of public entity crimes from bidding on or entering into contracts to furnish commodities or services to the Legislature in excess of a specified amount. Requires the Legislature to follow the same procedures with respect to acquisition of commodities and services competitive bidding as are imposed on agencies of the executive branch.
