Any previous violations committed by the violator. 1 2 (c) An enforcement board may reduce a fine imposed 3 pursuant to this section. 4 (d) A county or a municipality having a population 5 equal to or greater than 50,000 may adopt, by a vote of at least a majority plus one of the entire governing body of the 6 7 county or municipality, an ordinance that gives code 8 enforcement boards or special masters, or both, authority to impose fines in excess of the limits set forth in paragraph 9 10 (a). Such fines shall not exceed \$1,000 per day per violation for a first violation, \$5,000 per day per violation for a 11 12 repeat violation, and up to \$15,000 per violation if the code 13 enforcement board or special master finds the violation to be 14 irreparable or irreversible in nature. In addition to such 15 fines, a code enforcement board or special master may impose additional fines to cover all costs incurred by the local 16 17 government in enforcing its codes and all costs of repairs 18 pursuant to subsection (1).
