Section 402.09, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 13 14 402.09 Traumatic brain injury.--15 The Department of Children and Family Services shall, contingent upon specific appropriations, establish a 16 17 program of long-term community-based supports and services for individuals who have sustained traumatic brain injuries and 18 19 whose needs cannot be met through other programs related to 20 brain injury which are located within the Department of Health, the Department of Labor and Employment Security, or 21 22 the Department of Children and Family Services, or whose needs 23 cannot be met through any other programs for which they may be eligible. The determination-of-eligibility process for this 24 25 program must include a process for ensuring that the 26 individual is ineligible for other programs or has needs that 27 cannot be met through other programs of the department or 28 other agencies for which he or she is eligible. This program 29 is to be the program of last resort for individuals who have 30 sustained traumatic brain injuries. Supports and services may be purchased by department staff. This program is intended to

1	prevent inappropriate residential and institutional placements
2	and must be designed to enhance or maximize the individual's
3	independence.
4	(2) The Department of Children and Family Services
5	shall adopt rules for implementing and administering the
6	program and shall establish the eligibility criteria for
7	individuals who apply for and receive services from the
8	program.
9	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
10	law.
