Notwithstanding 22 any other provisions of this part, the structuring and 23 financing of an accounts receivable program pursuant to this subsection shall constitute a project and may be structured 24 25 for the benefit of health facilities within or outside the geographical limits of the local agency. An accounts 26 27 receivable program may include the financing of accounts 28 receivable acquired by a health facility from other 29 not-for-profit health care corporations health facilities, 30 whether or not controlled by or affiliated with the health 31 1
