23	(2) The commission may require that an alligator hide		
24	validation tag be affixed to the hide of any alligator taken		
25	from the wild and that such hide be possessed, purchased,		
26	sold, offered for sale, or transported in accordance with		
27	commission rule. The commission is authorized to assess a fee		
28	of up to <del>\$25</del> <del>\$30</del> for each alligator hide validation tag		
29	issued. <u>Additionally, there is a, of which \$5 charge</u> per		
30	validated hide, excluding those validated from public hunt		
31	programs, <u>which shall</u> <del>may</del> be transferred to the General		

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1 Inspection Trust Fund, to be administered by the Department of  
 2 Agriculture and Consumer Services for the purpose of providing  
 3 marketing and education services with respect to alligator  
 4 products produced in this state, notwithstanding other  
 5 provisions in this chapter.
