- (b) All state agencies are directed to cooperate with and provide assistance to the task force to the fullest extent possible.
- (c) The task force members shall not receive remuneration for the services but shall be reimbursed for travel and per diem expenses in accordance with 112.062, F.S.
- (3) In order to ensure consistency in the definitions and standards to be applied to each district for the purposes of awards of effort index grants, the task force shall visit each district which applies for an effort index grant and conduct a review of the five year district facilities work program to validate the basis for the effort index grant application.
- (b) The task force shall issue a report to the Governor, Speaker of the House, and President of the Senate no later than February 1, 2000, proposing any recommended statutory changes related to the Effort Index Grant program.
