I. Amendments Contained in Message

House Amendment 1 -- 983363 to the Senate Bill

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message

House Amendment 1 deletes from the Senate Bill language specifying that under the proposed Retention of Military Installations Program up to \$1.2 million may be provided to assist military installations potentially affected by federal base closure or realignment. It also deletes language specifying that an eligible recipient under this program is a provider of simulation solutions for war-fighting experimentation, testing, and training that employs a specified number of employees or a joint military command in a charter county.

This amendment also deletes from the Senate Bill an appropriation of \$800,000 to implement military base retention programs.
