## I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Florida Investment Incentive Trust Fund without modification effective November 4, 2000. The Florida Investment Incentive Trust Fund, FLAIR #312293, is administered by the Executive Office of the Governor. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-13, L.O.F.

## II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

#### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

#### 1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 288.711, F.S., creates the trust fund, provides for its purpose, and provides for its revenue.

#### 2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

Used for investments or loans to encourage the development of financial mechanisms in the private sector to capitalize and assist in the development of black business enterprises.

# 3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

Income earned from private sector investments shall be deposited into the fund to carry out the purpose of ss. 9-21, Chapter 85-104, L.O.F. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$0.00.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

## III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:
