I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Tourism Promotional Trust Fund without modification effective November 4, 2000. The Tourism Promotional Trust Fund, FLAIR \#312722, is administered by the Executive Office of the Governor. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-17, L.O.F.
II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:
A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 288.122, F.S., creates the trust fund and provides for its purpose.
2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

Funds the operations and activities of the Florida Commission on Tourism including but not limited to promotion and advertising.
3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

Rental car surcharge. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were $\$ 30.7$ million.
B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
C. STATUTE(S) AFFECTED:

None.
III. FISCAL ANALYSIS \& ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
