(1) The Displaced Homemaker Trust Fund 24 within the Department of Education, Division of Community 25 26 Colleges, FLAIR number 48-2-160, which is created by section 446.50, Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated 27 28 pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State 29 Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 30
