6	It deletes from the bill the requirement that the certificate be filed when a condominium changes ownership.
7	It requires that the certificate be filed with the clerk of the circuit court as opposed to with the county tax collector.
8	It adds to the bill an amendment to s. 468.4315, F.S., to provide the Regulatory Council of Community Association
9	provide the Regulatory Council of Community Association Managers the authority to adopt rules on continuing education
10	providers.
