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### I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Nursing Student Loan Forgiveness Program Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Nursing Student Loan Forgiveness Program Trust Fund, FLAIR #482505, is administered by the Department of Education. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 96-119, L.O.F.

### II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

#### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

#### MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 240.4075, F.S., creates the trust fund and provides several revenue sources for the fund. Section 240.4076, F.S., provides additional revenue sources for the fund.

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

This fund provides loan repayments to nurses to encourage employment in nursing homes and hospitals in the state and in state-operated medical and health care facilities, birth centers, federally sponsored community health centers and teaching hospitals by making repayments toward loans received by students from federal or state programs or commercial lending institutions for the support of postsecondary study in accredited or approved nursing programs.

# MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are the private health care industry and other private sources, licensing fees and additional fees for nursing licensure, scholarship repayments for those who default, and interest earned on the fund. According to Comptroller data, nonoperating revenues for this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$1,899,370.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
