A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to education; amending s.  
233.0612, F.S.; authorizing school districts to  
provide instruction in the history of labor;  
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (6) through (11) of section  
233.0612, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, are renumbered as  
subsections (7) through (12), respectively, and a new  
subsection (6) is added to said section to read:

233.0612 Authorized instruction.--Each school district  
may provide students with programs and instruction at the  
appropriate grade levels in areas including, but not limited  
to, the following:

(6) The history of labor in the United States and  
Florida, including the historical legacy of labor as given by  
each successive generation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999.
