## I. <u>SUMMARY</u>:

This legislation re-creates the Food and Nutrition Services Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Food and Nutrition Services Trust Fund, FLAIR #482315, is administered by the Department of Education. This fund was last re-created effective November 4,1996, by Chapter 95-103, L.O.F.

#### II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 228.195, F.S., requires the State Board of Education to prescribe rules and standards for all phases of the administration and operation of school food service programs.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The purpose of the fund is to record the revenue and disbursement of funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for the various school and day care food programs authorized by the National School Lunch Act.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major source of revenue for the fund is federal food service funds. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$392.2 million.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

C. STATUTE(S) AFFECTED:

None.

# III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
