(1) The Food and Nutrition Services Trust Fund, FLAIR number 48-2-315, which was created within the 23 Department of Education and which is to be terminated pursuant 24 to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on 25 26 November 4, 2000, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 27 28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 are continued. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000.
