### I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the State University System Replacement Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The State University System Replacement Trust Fund, FLAIR #492580, is administered by the State University System. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 95-28, L.O.F.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The trust fund is used as a facilitator account for the deposit of fire insurance claim proceeds from the Department of Insurance.

MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are fire insurance claim proceeds. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$179,546.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
