(1) The University of Florida Health 23 Center Incidental Trust Fund, FLAIR number 49-2-381, which was 24 created within the Department of Education and which is to be 25 26 terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 2000, is re-created. 27 28 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried

forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund

are continued.
