21	policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for
22	its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

24	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

26	Section 1. (1) The Education and General Student and
27	Other Fees Trust Fund within the Department of Education,
28	FLAIR number 49-2-164, which was created by section 240.209,
29	Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to
30	Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on July
31	<u>1, 1999, is re-created.</u>
