### I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the University of Florida Agricultural Extension Service Federal Grant Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000 The University of Florida Agricultural Extension Service Federal Grant Trust Fund, FLAIR #492216, is administered by Department of Education. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 95-11, L.O.F.

# II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

#### A. PRESENT SITUATION:

# 1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Sections 240.501, F.S., and 240.503, F.S., authorize the Board of Regents to receive federal grants of money for agricultural extension activities. The trust fund is not named in these statutes.

#### 2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The purpose of this fund is to account for the receipt and expenditures of federal formula funds provided for agricultural extension services, pursuant to the Smith-Lever Act.

# 3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major source of revenue is federal grants and moneys appropriated under the Smith-Lever Act. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$4.3 million.

#### B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

# III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:
