Paragraph (a) of subsection (6) of section 216.136, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, is amended to 18 19 read: 20 216.136 Consensus estimating conferences; duties and 21 principals.--22 (6) SOCIAL SERVICES ESTIMATING CONFERENCE.--23 (a) Duties.--The Social Services Estimating Conference shall 24 1. 25 develop such official information relating to the social services system of the state, including forecasts of social 26 27 services and Medicaid caseloads, as the conference determines 28 is needed for the state planning and budgeting system. Such official information shall include, but not be limited to, 29 30 subsidized child care caseloads mandated by the Family Support 31 Act of 1988.

In addition, the Social Services Estimating 2 Conference shall develop estimates and forecasts of the 3 unduplicated count of children eligible for subsidized child care as defined in s. 402.3015(1). These estimates and 4 5 forecasts shall not include children enrolled in the б prekindergarten early intervention program established in s. 7 230.2305. 8 3. The Department of Children and Family Health and 9 Rehabilitative Services and the Department of Education shall 10 provide information on caseloads and waiting lists for the 11 subsidized child care and prekindergarten early intervention programs requested by the Social Services Estimating 12 13 Conference or individual conference principals, in a timely 14 manner. 15 The Department of Children and Family Services and 4. the Department of Education shall provide information on 16 17 caseloads and waiting lists for people who have developmental disabilities as they relate to individuals eligible for or 18 19 receiving services under the developmental services home and community-based waiver program. The Social Services Estimating 20 Conference shall use this and other pertinent data to estimate 21 the annual cost of providing home and community-based 22 services. This estimate shall be included in the official 23 24 estimate produced by the conference. An annual increase based 25 on the medical component of the consumer price index-urban shall also be included in the conference estimates. 26 27 Section 2.
