1 Senate Resolution No. \_\_\_\_ 2 A resolution urging public support for quality 3 child care. 4 WHEREAS, March 16, 1999 has been designated as 5 6 Children's Day by the Florida Legislature, and WHEREAS, choosing quality child care is an important 7 8 children's issue, and 9 WHEREAS, a positive loving relationship between a provider and the child is essential for the delivery of 10 quality child care, and 11 12 WHEREAS, it is important that parents choose a provider whose style and attitudes are similar to their own, and 13 WHEREAS, quality child care programs should include 14 age-appropriate materials to help children learn and grow; 15 activities encouraging children to think creatively; time for 16 17 children to work as a group and time to play alone; and the posting of schedules by the provider, and 18 19 WHEREAS, physical environment is a critical component 20 of quality child care because it affects children's safety, 21 health, and development, and 22 WHEREAS, a provider must provide enough adults for the 23 number and age of children in a group to ensure quality, and WHEREAS, quality child care facilities must be 24 25 cheerful, clean, and equipped with adequate materials, and 26 WHEREAS, all children need the same things, and 27 recognizing that each child sees things in a different way, it 28 is important to see quality child care through a child's eyes, 29 NOW, THEREFORE, 30 31 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida:

1	That all residents of this state are encouraged to
2	support quality child care, and parents are especially
3	encouraged to visit programs more than once at different times
4	over several days before selecting a child care provider.
