(1) The Excellent Teaching Program Trust 27 Fund within the Department of Education, FLAIR number 28 48-2-206, which was created by chapter 98-210, Laws of 29 Florida, and assigned to section 236.08107, Florida Statutes, 30 and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2002, unless 31 1

terminated sooner by law, is hereby terminated on November 4, 2000, and re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. б Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 236.08107, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, is repealed. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000. HOUSE SUMMARY Re-creates the Excellent Teaching Program Trust Fund within the Department of Education and places it on the standard review cycle.
