A bill to be entitled
An act relating to trust funds; re-creating the
Agricultural Emergency Eradication Trust Fund
within the Department of Agriculture and
Consumer Services without modification and
placing it on the standard review cycle;
carrying forward current balances and
continuing current sources and uses thereof;
providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of
the Agricultural Emergency Eradication Trust Fund within the
Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, which is
otherwise scheduled to be terminated pursuant to
constitutional mandate, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the trust fund
before its scheduled termination date and has found that it
continues to meet an important public purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public
policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for
its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Agricultural Emergency Eradication
Trust Fund within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer
Services, FLAIR number 42-2-360, which was created by section
570.191, Florida Statutes, and which is to be terminated
pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State
Constitution on July 1, 2002, unless terminated sooner by law,
is hereby terminated on November 4, 2000, and re-created.
