A bill to be entitled An act relating to the Florida Retirement System; directing the director of the Division of Retirement to conduct an actuarial study of the feasibility of permitting wartime veterans employed in the system to claim certain military service as additional years of employment for retirement purposes; providing for a report to the Legislature; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. <u>Purchase of military service by wartime</u> veterans; actuarial study required; report.--
- (1) The director of the Division of Retirement is hereby directed to have an actuarial study conducted with respect to the cost of permitting wartime veterans who have been employed on or after January 1, 1987, under the Florida Retirement System to purchase military service as additional years of employment for retirement purposes under the Florida Retirement System.
- (2) The director of the Division of Retirement shall report the findings of the actuarial study, together with any recommended legislation necessary to implement the study on or before the first day of the 2000 Regular Session of the Legislature to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY Requires the director of the Division of Retirement to conduct an actuarial study of the feasibility of permitting wartime veterans employed in the Florida Retirement System on or after January 1, 1987, to purchase military service as additional years of service for retirement purposes and to report on or before the the commencement of the 2000 Regular Session of the Legislature on the outcome of the study together with suggested legislation to provide for the purchase of such service. service.
