I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000 and places it on the standard review cycle. The Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund, FLAIR #79-2-2719, is administered by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. This fund was created effective July 1, 1998, by Chapter 98-393, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 561.027, F.S., creates the trust fund.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The purpose of the trust fund is to provide a separate federal forfeiture trust fund solely for the deposit of trust fund receipts and revenues received as a result of federal criminal, administrative, or civil forfeiture proceedings and receipts received from federal asset sharing programs.

MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the fund are receipts and revenues received as a result of federal criminal, administrative, or civil forfeiture proceedings and receipts and revenues from federal asset sharing programs. Because the trust fund was created in 1998, there is no applicable receipt data for FY 1997-98.

EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
