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I. SUMMARY:

This legislation re-creates the Solid Waste Management Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2000. The Solid Waste Management Trust Fund, FLAIR #37-2-644, is administered by the Department of Environmental Protection. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 95-50, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

Section 403.709, F.S., creates and specifies purposes of the trust fund. Sections 212.20, 403.708, 403.7095, 403.718, 403.7186, 403.7195, and 403.759, F.S., provide revenue sources and deposit instructions for the fund.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The trust fund supports solid waste management activities of the department including technical assistance to local governments, educational programs, and regulation and enforcement.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

The major sources of revenue for the trust fund are a percentage of the state sales tax, waste tire fees, and permit fees. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$118.5 million.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.
