(1) The Solid Waste Management Trust Fund 23 within the Department of Environmental Protection, FLAIR number 37-2-644, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 24 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 25 26 2000, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 27 28 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 29 are continued. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000. 31
