A bill to be entitled

An act relating to plastic or cosmetic surgery;
requiring certain advertisements for such
surgery or procedures in an unlicensed setting
to contain a warning relating to the potential
dangers; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. In the text of any written advertisement
for plastic or cosmetic surgery or procedures that are
performed in a setting that is not licensed under chapter 395,
Florida Statutes, whether for surgery or procedures that are
deemed to be elective or medically necessary, the following
statement must appear in capital letters clearly
distinguishable from the rest of the text: "AS WITH ANY
SURGERY, PLASTIC OR COSMETIC SURGERY CARRIES RISKS OF
UNINTENDED SERIOUS BODILY INJURY OR DEATH. CONSULT A LICENSED
PHYSICIAN CONCERNING THESE RISKS BEFORE SUBMITTING TO PLASTIC
OR COSMETIC SURGERY." Any advertisement that has an audible
component must orally contain this statement verbatim.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires advertisements for plastic or cosmetic surgery
or procedures to be conducted in an unlicensed setting to
contain a specific warning of the potential dangers.
