pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State

Constitution on July 1, 2001, unless terminated sooner by law, is hereby terminated on November 4, 2000, and re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 2. Subsection (3) of section 403.8533, Florida Statutes, is repealed. Section 3. This act shall take effect November 4, 2000.
