(1) The Rehabilitation Administrative Expense Fund within the Department of Insurance, FLAIR number 23 46-2-582, which was created by section 641.227, Florida 24 Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 25 26 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 27 2000, is re-created. 28 (2) All current balances of the fund are carried 29 forward, and all current sources and uses of the fund are 30 continued. 31
