Subsections (40) and (42) of section 10 228.041, Florida Statutes, 1998 Supplement, are amended to read: 11 12 228.041 Definitions.--Specific definitions shall be as follows, and wherever such defined words or terms are used in 13 the Florida School Code, they shall be used as follows: 14 (40) GRADUATION RATE. -- The term "graduation rate" 15 means the percentage calculated by dividing the number of 16 17 entering 9th graders, minus the number of students who have transferred out of the student population to enroll in another 18 19 school system, a private school, a home education program, or 20 an adult education program, and deceased students, into the 21 number of students who receive, 4 years later, a standard high 22 school diploma, a special diploma, or a certificate of completion, as provided for in s. 232.246, or who receive a 23 special certificate of completion, as provided in s. 232.247, 24 25 and students 19 years of age or younger who receive a general 26 equivalency diploma, as provided in s. 229.814. For purposes 27 of this calculation, incoming transfer students are to be 28 included in the class of entering 9th graders with whom they are scheduled to graduate. The number of 9th grade students 29 30 used in the calculation of a graduation rate for this state 31 shall be students enrolling in the grade for the first time. 1

(42) DROPOUT RATE.--The term "dropout rate" means the annual percentage calculated by dividing the number of students in grades 9 through 12 who are classified as dropouts, pursuant to s. 228.041(29), by the total number of students in grades 9-12 in attendance over the age of compulsory school attendance, pursuant to s. 232.01, at the б time of the fall membership count, into the number of students who withdraw from school during a given school year and who are classified as dropouts pursuant to subsection (29). Section 2.
