(1) The Corporation Tax Administration Trust Fund within the Department of Revenue, FLAIR number 23 73-2-134, which was created by section 213.31, Florida 24 Statutes, and which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 25 26 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on November 4, 27 2000, is re-created. 28 (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 29 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. 30 31
