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I. SUMMARY:

his legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification effective November 4, 2000. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund, FLAIR #73-2-339, is administered by the Department of Revenue. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 1996, by Chapter 95-225, Laws of Florida.

II. SUBSTANTIVE ANALYSIS:

A. PRESENT SITUATION:

1. MAJOR STATUTES THAT CONTROL THE TRUST FUND:

This fund was re-created by Chapter 95-225, L.O.F.

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE FUND'S USES OR PURPOSES:

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund was established to control and account for federal revenue and associated expenditures.

3. MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE FOR THE FUND:

Primary revenues for FY 1997-98 were from federal grants. According to Comptroller data, receipts to this fund for FY 1997-98 were \$112.5 million.

B. EFFECT OF PROPOSED CHANGES:

This bill re-creates the trust fund without modification.

III. FISCAL ANALYSIS & ECONOMIC IMPACT STATEMENT:

This legislation has no fiscal impact on state agencies or state funds, on local governments as a whole or on the private sector. It simply re-creates, without modification, an existing state trust fund and continues the current use of the fund.
