However, nothing in this 14 15 subsection may be interpreted to permit an alteration of a prescriber's directions, the diagnosis or treatment of any 16 17 disease, the initiation of any drug therapy, the practice of 18 medicine, or the practice of osteopathic medicine, unless 19 otherwise permitted by law.
