:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, lines 23-30, delete those lines

and insert: examination and a certification of having passed a school-entry vision screening or of having taken a comprehensive vision examination and analysis after failing a vision screening. The required health examination and vision test must have been performed within 1 year prior to enrollment in school. The school board of each district, and the governing authority of each nonpublic school, may establish a policy which permits a student up to 30 school days to present a certification of a school-entry health examination and up to 120 days to present a certification of a school-entry vision screening and, if required, a certification of a comprehensive vision
