Section 261.11, Florida Statutes, is 10 created to read: 11 261.11 The Off-Highway Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund.--There is created the Off-Highway Vehicle Revolving 12 13 Trust Fund to be administered by the Division of Forestry within the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. 14 15 (1) The trust fund shall consist of deposits from the 16 following sources: 17 (a) Fees paid to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for the titling and registration of off-highway 18 19 vehicles. 20 (b) Revenues and income from any other source required by law or as appropriated by the Legislature to be deposited 21 22 into the fund. 23 (c) Donations from private sources. 24 (d) Interest earned on moneys on deposit in the fund. 25 (2) Moneys in the trust fund shall be available for 26 recommended allocation by the Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation 27 Advisory Committee and the Department of Agriculture and 28 Consumer Services and upon annual appropriation by the 29 Legislature, exclusively for the following: (a) Implementation of the Off-Highway Vehicle 30 Recreation Program by the Department of Agriculture and 31 1

Consumer Services which includes personnel and other related 1 2 expenses, administrative and operating expenses, expenses 3 related to safety, training, and rider education programs, and, if funds are available, acquisition of lands to be 4 5 included in the Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Program's 6 system of lands and trails and management and maintenance of 7 such lands. 8 (b) Approved grants to governmental agencies and 9 entities that wish to provide off-highway vehicle recreation areas or trails for public use. 10 11 (c) Matching funds to be used to match off-highway 12 vehicle recreation grant funds available from other sources, 13 including, but not limited to, grant funds available pursuant to the federal Recreational Trails Program. 14 15 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and 16 pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain therein and shall be 17 available for carrying out the purposes of this section and as 18 otherwise provided by law. 19 20 (4) Pursuant to the provisions of s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the Off-Highway Vehicle 21 22 Revolving Trust Fund, unless terminated sooner, shall be terminated on July 1, 2003. However, prior to its scheduled 23 termination, the Off-Highway Vehicle Revolving Trust Fund 24 25 shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2). 26 Section 2.
