Section 1. Section 228.3011, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

228.3011 Penalty for theft or reproduction of an examination.--

(1) Any person 18 years of age or older who commits a theft of an examination administered by or through the department, the State Board of Education, or the Commissioner of Education, commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

(2) Any person 18 years of age or older who reproduces or copies, in whole or in part, any examination administered by or through the department, the State Board of Education, or the Commissioner of Education, without the authorization of the department, the State Board of Education, or the Commissioner of Education, commits a felony of the third
